

As directed by Governor Cooper's Executive Order 147, face coverings are **REQUIRED** to enter.

If you are not wearing a face covering that covers your mouth and nose, you may *only* enter if you:

- Have a medical or behavioral condition or disability
- Are under eleven (11) years of age
- Are actively eating or drinking;
- Are seeking to communicate with someone who is hearing-impaired in a way that requires the mouth to be visible;
- Are temporarily removing your Face Covering to secure government or medical services or for identification purposes;
- Are a child whose parent, guardian, or responsible person has been unable to place the Face Covering safely on the child's face.
